Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FIV) Prevention

FIV, or feline aids, is a potentially fatal viral disease that interferes with the immune system of a cat. The virus lives in the blood of the infected cat and is carried throughout its life. FIV is spread from cat to cat primarily through bite wounds as the virus is shed in high levels through saliva.

Between 14% and 29% of cats in Australia test positive to the disease.
